Several theatre stars will join composer/lyricist Georgia Stitt for a concert celebrating her work Dec. 27. Among those scheduled to take part in Georgia Stitt & Friends are Urban Cowboy's Jenn Colella, Parade's Andrea Burns, Elegies' Keith Byron Kirk, Hairspray's Matthew Morrison and The Wild Party's Julia Murney.

Show time is 7 PM at the famed jazz club Birdland.

A composer, lyricist, musical director, conductor, arranger and pianist, Georgia Stitt's musicals include *The Water and Liza*. She is also currently developing two new musicals: *My Mercury* and *Sing Me a Happy Song*. Stitt was the assistant conductor for the Broadway bow of *Little Shop of Horrors* and the associate conductor for *Encores!* mounting of *Can-Can*. A recipient of the ASCAP Frederick Loewe Fellowship and the Sue Brewer Award for excellence in music composition, Stitt is married to Tony Award-winning composer Jason Robert Brown.
