PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE

Sergeant Position

Mr. Sullivan stated that the sergeant's position was previously approved by the Board but the position has not been filled. The department needs a second in command to keep things smooth and professional. Many area departments are using lieutenants instead of sergeants because of union issues. There will be an interview process for interested department members and the Chief will make a choice based on that process.

No Committee member had a problem with the change to lieutenant.

Citizen Request for Signage at Intersection of Cedar and N. Cherry

Mr. Mitchell reported that a citizen has requested a yield or stop sign at the intersection of Cedar and N. Cherry.

Mr. Sullivan recommended no change at the intersection. There have been no accidents at that intersection since at least January of 2003.

It was the consensus of the Committee to recommend no change at the intersection.
